

Location:

Soar Valley Canoe Club. Leicester OPC, Loughborough Road, Leicester



Venue – Soar Valley Canoe Club, situated on the A6030, adjacent to the Leicester outdoor pursuits centre (<u>http://www.lopc.co.uk/)</u>, Loughborough Road, Birstall, Leicester, LE4 5PN. From the A46 Leicester by-pass take the A6 into Leicester, continue until you reach a large roundabout with a flyover going over it. Take the third exit following signs to the outdoor centre. The entrance is approximately 50 metres on the left immediately after leaving the roundabout.

Please follow the signs and instructions from the marshals. Parking arrangements may be altered at short notice if heavy rain precedes the race.


Course

The course is a ten mile there-and-back route. It starts on steps leading to the water. The start is donated by a union flag.


The course encompasses the river Soar, Grand Union canal and river Wreake.











Proceed downstream to the first portage is at one mile. Paddle up to the lock gate on the LEFT hand side (not the tow path side). Get out and traverse the length of the lock, past the bridge and put in. The drop to the water is about one metre, so take care.











The second portage at Thurmaston Lock, is one mile further on. As you approach the lock, get out on the left, traverse the lock and get back in.







The third portage Junction Lock, is at 4.25 miles. Get out on the right hand side, traverse the length of the lock and get back in.









The turn is at five miles, just before the Cossington lock. Turn in an anti-clockwise direction and follow the course back to the start portaging the locks in reverse order (obviously!!).



It is wholly the responsibility of the paddler to know the course. Any deviation from the course with result in no time being given. There will be maps, course diagrams, Marshalls, signs and flags to show the course.

Results

The results will be available at the canoe club when the last boat has finished. They will also be published on the web

site.
